he Bible is a reference library, in prose and poetry, of Divine law, history, theology, prophecy and guidance for daily living and devotion. Although composed of 66 books on varying subjects and recorded by different writers over a period of many centuries, it constitutes a coherent revelation of man's relationship to God and to His plan and purpose with the earth.

The fullest benefits will be obtained from an intimate familiarity with the Bible as a whole. To this end many have adopted a daily reading plan, by which they read the entire Bible in the course of a year. Others might be attracted to such a plan if they could see a more easily recognizable basis of coherence in the order of readings. History offers one such basis, making many of the non-historical books more understandable by presenting them in their original setting.

This historical plan presents, first, eleven books of the Old Testament and two books of the New Testament which form an historical framework for the whole Bible, although there is a gap of four centuries between the Old Testament and the New. In this period the Grecian Empire arose, the Maccabbees tried to re-establish an independent Jewish state and the rising Roman power came into Palestine as an ally of the Jews and remained as their overlord.

The historical plan then starts again at the beginning and presents the whole Bible as nearly as possible in chronological order. The relative dates of most books can be determined with reasonable assurance. The others are placed at least in an

appropriate setting. Some of the prophetic books (eg. Jeremiah, Daniel) are themselves collections of writings without chronological arrangement. Some rearrangement of chapters and even parts of chapters has been made. Similarly, some gospel writers make more attempt than others to present events in chronological order. The readings try to group similar accounts together and in their proper sequence.

The Psalms involve particular difficulties. They were written over a considerable period of time. David is acknowledged as the chief contributor but the traditional inscriptions regarding authors are not always reliable and some psalms have no inscription at all. In the readings most psalms are listed at the time they are known or are likely to have been written, but some are attached to events which they describe (e.g. the creation) or to which they are appropriate, without regard to the date of writing. Others were sung in groups, as at the dedication of the temple, and on certain days these may constitute the entire reading.

Once the entire Bible has been read on the Historical Plan, and a relationship between its parts has been established, any system of daily Bible reading will have additional meaning. Many are familiar with the "Bible Companion" system, whereby the Old Testament is covered once and the New Testament twice during the year. For those who wish to combine the main features of both systems, the Historical Bible Reading Plan lists a portion of the Old and New Testament for each day's reading but in the same historical sequence as the Bible Companion.
